Check-in (5-15 minutes)

The receptionist at the front desk will be checking you in and making sure all of your paperwork is filled in. If you are a new patient, your check-in will be much more timely and efficient if your paperwork has already been filled out prior to your appointment.



Testing (~ 20 minutes)

A technician will take you to our pre-testing room and perform a corneal topography scan to obtain a map of the front surface of your eye(s).

You will be then escorted to an exam room where the technician will check your vision. They will also have several questions for you regarding your reasons and motivation for having laser vision correction.

The technician will speak with the doctor and will show you a video that will explain the laser vision correction procedure the doctor has recommended for you.



Doctor Visit

You will meet with the doctor to discuss your candidacy for laser vision correction, which procedure you qualify best for and answer any auestions.



Patient Counselor (~ 20 minutes)
