



# Check-in (5-15 minutes)

The receptionist at the front desk will be checking you in and making sure all of your paperwork is filled out and checking your insurance. If you paid for your eye drops already, they will hand you a drop kit.



## Testing (15-30 minutes)

A technician will look over your chart and see if you need any more testing done prior to your surgery today. If so, they will complete any and all testing needed. They will also go over your post-surgery instructions and can give you relaxing medication (typically Ativan – which is like Valium) if you'd like.



#### **Optometrist Visit**

The optometrist will make sure all testing is done and recheck your prescription if needed.



### **Surgeon Visit**

Dr. Paul Dougherty will meet with you to answer any questions or concerns you may have regarding the surgery.



### Surgery (10-30 minutes)

Our surgery team will take you into the surgery area and prepare you for the procedure.
